How much shale oil does Argentina produce a day?

Argentina's shale oil production currently is around 400,000 barrels per day. "But for that to happen, other things are needed: more infrastructure to bring the oil to the ports, and many more people in the workforce and more equipment." More people are starting to believe the dream that Argentina could become a serious global energy player.

Why is Argentina's oil industry paralyzed?

For more than a decade, Argentina's oil industry was paralyzed by policy mismanagement and financial instability. Oil majors from around the world - once attracted by the promise of the vast Vaca Muerta shale basin - had left the country, discouraged by the impossibility of converting peso-denominated revenues into hard currency.

Why is fracking a problem in Argentina?

Argentina has seen a boom in the number of fracking wells used to produce shale oil and gas in recent years. The local governor says Anelo has added 1,000 residents in the last year. This has strained local infrastructure, a broader challenge for growth.

Should Argentina export liquefied natural gas?

Production costs of \$1.60 per million British thermal units are lower than US prices, and cheap enough to make liquefied natural gas (LNG) exports viable. Argentina wants to become an important exporter of LNG, with up to 30 million tonnes of annual capacity, not far short of half of Qatar's current level.
